#### **PRIVACY POLICY**

Last Updated: January 12, 2026

Hit List, LLC, a Wyoming limited liability company (“**Company**”, “**we**”, “**us**” or “**our**”) recognizes the importance of protecting the privacy of information provided by users of and visitors to its website, [www.submissionaccess.com](http://www.submissionaccess.com) (the “**Site**”). Because of our commitment to our users (“**you**” or “**your**”) and their privacy, we have established the following Privacy Policy (“**Policy**”) which explains what personal information we collect from users of the Site, and what we do with such information. This Policy applies solely to information collected through the Site.

#### **PURPOSE OF THE SITE**

The Site exists for the limited purpose of allowing users, subject to specified terms, conditions and requirements, to submit materials to us for consideration. Information collected from users by and through the Site is in service of and relevant to that limited purpose.

All personal information, professional information, ideas for literary or entertainment programming, audio, audiovisual, photographic and/or other works or content, stories, formats, plots, scripts, takes, treatments or other literary or creative materials, characters, drawings, or any other information, ideas, proposals, suggestions or content which you voluntarily submit or otherwise provide to Company (“**Materials**”) are governed by Company’s Submission Agreement which users must review, acknowledge and accept as a condition of submitting any Materials. Personal information included in submissions is processed and handled in accordance with this Policy and the Submission Agreement.

#### **CHILDREN’S PRIVACY**

The Site is intended for users 18 years of age or older. Submissions by individuals under the age of 18 are prohibited. We do not knowingly collect personal information or submissions from individuals under 18. Any such information will be deleted if discovered.

#### **WHAT INFORMATION WE COLLECT**

At present we only collect personally identifiable information (“**PII**” or “**personal information**”) in the following ways: (1) personal information you elect to provide in relation to the submission of materials through the Site, and (2) personal information we obtain from Internet or electronic activity and analytics data. In addition, we may collect device IDs and IP addresses from Site users, which is considered PII in certain jurisdictions.

More specifically, we collect the following personal information from these sources:

- When making submissions, you will be asked to provide: your name, physical address, email address, company name (if applicable), phone number and confirmation that you are at least 18 years of age.
- Certain content management and measurement services that we may use collect device identifiers (such as IP address and device ID), date and time of Site access by users and mobile network information including phone number, which enables us to gather aggregate demographic

information about our users, and in certain cases provides us with more detailed demographics about Site users.

- We do not collect or hold any credit card information in relation to the Site.

#### **HOW WE USE INFORMATION WE COLLECT**

- Certain information, such as personal information you provide in order to submit materials and information contained in any materials you submit, may be used to evaluate and review submitted materials and to communicate with you regarding your submission(s).
- Certain information, such as personal information you provide in order to submit materials and information contained in any materials you submit, may also be used to maintain Site security and functionality, and to comply with legal obligations.
- Except as otherwise expressly noted in this Policy, we do not disclose personal information to third parties unless we have informed you, been authorized by you, or are required to disclose such information by law.
- We do not use personal information for marketing or advertising purposes.
- We may share with third parties the aggregated, non-personal information (e.g. number of users, etc.), as well as anonymized information such as Internet Protocol (IP) address, mobile ID and user agent. However, this information does not identify you individually, and generally this alone is not regarded as PII under applicable US law.
- We may share personal information, submitted materials and non-personal information with our parent, subsidiaries, related and affiliated entities, and the successors, assigns, licensees, representatives, consultants, and agents of the foregoing (“**Company Affiliates**”) for purposes of evaluating, handling and responding to submissions.
- We may share personal information, submitted materials and non-personal information with service providers who assist with Site hosting, security, analytics and related functions.
- We may share personal information, submitted materials and non-personal information as required by legal or regulatory authorities as required by law.

#### **USE OF COOKIES AND SIMILAR TECHNOLOGIES**

- We may use limited cookies and analytics tools solely for Site performance, security, and aggregate usage analysis. We do not use targeted advertising cookies and do not sell or share personal information for advertising purposes.

#### **DATA RETENTION**

We retain personal information only for as long as reasonably necessary to evaluate submissions, operate the Site, comply with legal obligations, and enforce our agreements. Submissions materials may be retained indefinitely.

#### **WEBSITE AND APPLICATION LINKS**

To the extent the Site contains links to third-party websites or applications, especially social media sites or applications, we are not responsible for the privacy practices, content or security of any other website or application, which are subject to the privacy policy(ies) (if any) on such website(s) or application(s).

## **SECURITY**

We implement reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards designed to protect personal information. However, no system can be completely secure.

## **CALIFORNIA RESIDENTS (CCPA/CPRA)**

California residents have the right to request access to, deletion of, and correction of their personal information, and to know what personal information is collected and for what purpose. The Company does not sell personal information or, except as otherwise noted in this Policy, share personal information.
